This is a skilled position which primarily involves preventative maintenance and repair of a large fleet of commercial transport vehicles including concrete mixer trucks, dump trucks, trailers, forklifts and light-duty trucks.

Duties include:

- Road test motor vehicles and test automotive systems and components
- Inspect, test, diagnose, adjust, repair and replace parts and components of electrical, mechanical and pneumatic systems
- Perform scheduled maintenance service
- Concrete plant maintenance and repair
- Complete reports to record problems and work performed
- Estimate parts and labour costs
- Maintain safety, health, and environmental policies and procedures
